Schedule A is a special appointing authority that agencies can use to non-competitively appoint individuals, including eligible veterans, who have a severe physical, psychiatric, or intellectual disability.

Submitting your Schedule A application does not entitle you to placement. Positions may not be available at the time you submit your application; however, your application will be forwarded in accordance with United States Marshals Service (USMS) policy should a vacancy in your desired field/area come available. Management may make a selection from any source, including advertising the position on USA Jobs. We highly encourage you to also look for positions of interest at <u>www.usajobs.gov</u>.
